

Proposed arrangements for the admission criteria for Malet Lambert for 2018-19

1. Children in public care at the time when preferences are expressed and who are still in public care at the time of their admission to school, and those who have been previously looked after.
2. Admission authorities may give priority in their oversubscription criteria to children of staff in either or both of the following circumstances:
 - a) where the member of staff has been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made, and/or
 - b) the member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
3. Being a resident in the catchment area of the school.
4. Those applicants who on the date of admission will have a sibling on the roll of Malet Lambert at the time of admission. Siblings (brothers or sisters) are considered to be those children who live at the same address and either
 - have one or both natural parents in common
 - are related by a parent's marriage
 - are adopted or are fostered
 - their parents are married/co-habiting and children live together in the same household
 - are children of the same household
5. Geographical, with priority given to those living nearest to the school
