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Malet Lambert School Collective Worship Policy

Purpose

This policy provides a framework and guidance for staff to deliver the statutory requirement for collective worship.

The school will ensure that:

- There is one assembly for each year group every week.
- The assemblies will follow a formal style to reinforce the traditional values of the school.
- The themes for the assemblies address moral, social, religious and cultural issues.
- There are a wide variety of outside speakers to talk to the students.

All teachers are expected to:

- Contribute to the whole school delivery of SMSC

Students will be encouraged to:

- Participate in discussion on topical issues in PSHCCEE and registration time.

Arrangements for monitoring and evaluation:

- Members of the Senior Leadership and Management Team deliver assemblies along with the Pastoral Leaders. Assemblies are observed and feedback given back to the Senior Leadership and Management Team.
- Pastoral Leaders formally observe registration time and informally visit tutor groups during the term, giving feedback to the Deputy Head (FPE).
