WHOLE SCHOOL INFORMATION

School Uniform

We have been really impressed by the vast majority of our pupils' uniform this half term and we know that parental support has been key to this. Thank you. For those pupils who need to locate and /or purchase uniform items, we would politely ask that this is done before the return to school after the Easter break please. On the first day back, we will be conducting thorough uniform checks. Those pupils who are not complying with our policy or without agreed medical notes, will not be in general circulation on the first day back.

We will aim to assist in remedying uniform issues as much as we can on the first day back, using our brand new or nearly new stock where necessary, but ultimately the responsibility for being in the correct uniform remains with the pupil and their family please.

PSHE content next term

- Years 7-9 will be looking at Health and Wellbeing. That will include grief: over lost friendships (y7), divorce and separation (y8) and death (y9). It is the last lesson in the unit and the list of lessons are on the board at the start, so students are aware that it's coming. Any issues can be raised with the teacher or us.
- Year 10 will be doing a unit on relationships and wellbeing, covering a recap of STIs and contraception, but also including self-harm and a specific study of men's mental health and suicide. Again, the list of lessons are on the board each time so students know what is coming up.

MIS Change

We are changing our Management Information System (MIS), which is the system we use for pupil and staff data. We currently use a system called SIMS and will be changing to a system called Arbor on Monday 8th April 2024.

Once we have made the change to Arbor, the SIMS Parent App will no longer be used as it does not link to the new system. It is important that you delete the SIMS Parent App from Monday 8th April 2024 and send any updates or communications directly to the school, rather than through the app.

Once the Arbor system is fully embedded, we will be launching the Arbor Parent App and Parent Portal. The Parent App can be downloaded to a smartphone and the Parent Portal is Web based. We hope to be able to launch these in the summer term. We will write to you with more details in due course.

There will not be a generic text message number for the school, instead you will each receive an individualised number that will be assigned to you from Arbor. We will send you all a text message on Monday 8th April, so you can save this into your mobile phone for future use.
