# SAFEGUARDING CORNER

#### Mental Health Focus - Pupil Challenge

There is no doubt that we are fully in festive mode now where there can be increasing focus on the cost and size of presents - the material side of Christmas.

Maintaining positive Mental Health can be a complex topic but one that we regularly address with our pupils in many different ways. At Christmas, with additional pressures, it is arguably even more important that we focus on positive Mental Health

Two top tips among many to achieve positive mental health are to show gratitude and to reach out to others to offer then help.

We are offering all of our pupils the chance to earn extra reward "stamps" over the weekend with two simple tasks along those lines.

These are optional tasks and clearly will need relevant guidance and making appropriate to each family setting.

- 1. Write down 5 elements (not physical items) of their life that they are thankful about. E.g. A caring step-mum, the chance to do sports that they love etc
- 2. Do something to help another person under the safe and relevant guidance of parents / carers. E.g. Take the bin back in for a neighbour /Collect some shopping for a relative etc

For pupils who do this they can collect from their tutor 1 stamp if they do one tasks and 3 stamps if they do both tasks

All we ask is that a parent pops a short note into your child's planner on the week 15 pages to state

" NAME did one/both MH challenges"

### **A** THINGS TO REMEMBER

#### **COLLECTING PUPILS FROM SCHOOL**

If you are collecting your child from school, for whatever reason, you must bring ID, if someone else is collecting your child on your behalf, they must also bring ID and must be an emergency contact on our SIMS record.

#### PARENTS/CARERS VISITING THE SCHOOL

As you are aware we are a very large secondary school and staff time is always taken up with appointments and duties. If you do need a face to face appointment with any member of staff, you will need to book a pre-arranged appointment. Please contact the school to arrange this. Unfortunately, if you do decide to come to the school without an appointment, the time you will be waiting to see a member of staff cannot be determined.

#### WORK EXPERIENCE

Please remember that there is a deadline of 17th March 2025 to return your completed Work Experience Self-Found Placement form. A parent or carer can object to any information in addition to their child's name, address and date of birth being passed to their local authority or provider of youth support services by informing us via email to

enquiries@maletlambert.hull.sch.uk. This right is transferred to the child / pupil once they reach the age 16. Data is securely transferred to the youth support service via encrypted email and is stored electronically and held for in accordance with the local authorities retention schedule.
