However in recent days you may have become aware of a WhatsApp Group (at other times it may well be a different platform - it just so happens that Whatsapp is the focus of some concerns.)

Rather than overly focusing on any one platform or one specific concern we try to educate our pupils about good and safe use of the various platforms in which positive and negative stories and impressions can be communicated to our young people.
