Summergangs Road

We have heard of a notification from Hull City Council – Highways Division Installation of Traffic Calming Measures on Summergangs Road

Hull City Council intends to carry out essential highway improvement works to the carriageway on Summergangs Road, they will be installing two speed (raised) tables and associated works to enforce a new 20mph speed limit.

This will impact traffic both ways on James Reckitt Avenue.

Phase 1 (Monday 10th February – Friday 21st February) Phase 1 will consist of the installation of a speed (raised) table near to James Reckitt Avenue which will take up to two weeks and will be complete under a road closure. Whilst the road closure is in place there will be a diversion route in place which will direct motorists to divert on to James Reckitt Avenue and then Ings Road and finally Holderness Road and vice versa.

Phase 2 (Monday 24th February – Friday 7th March) Phase 2 will also consist of the installation of a speed (raised) table near to Swinburne Street which will only commence once Phase 1 has been completed as Phase 2 will be carried out under a road closure.

As far back as October 2022 we shared some information with parent about the rising number of school aged children who are vaping and we shared information again last year.

A THINGS TO REMEMBER

COLLECTING PUPILS FROM SCHOOL
